

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION FOR BOLON STUDIO

General

Requirements and preparation is the same as for corresponding instruction for tiles. However, there are some differences and these are described in this manual.

Before installation

The purpose with Bolon Studio is to provide opportunity for creative installations. Depending on the tile's shape and how they are installed in relation to each other, different effect/pattern arises.

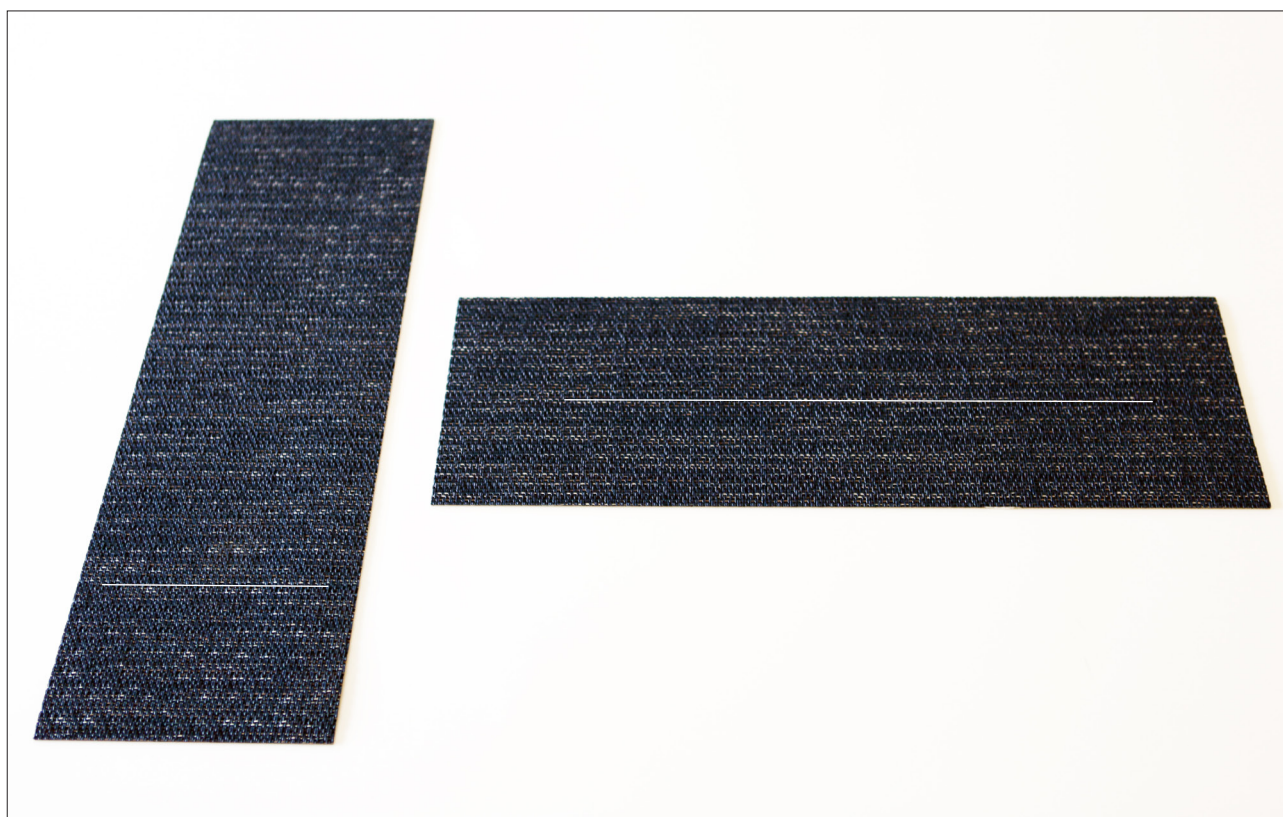
Some shapes is delivered with quarter turned pattern see picture 1. In these cases about 50% is delivered in each direction.

Therefore, please confirm with client how the tiles should be installed before installation begins.

Installation

Bolon Studio tiles are based on wall to wall material. Therefore always use permanent adhesive to avoid possible curling.

Tiles with corner different from 90°, such as triangles and wing, are harder to fit than traditional tiles. To make sure a good installation it requires a subfloor leveled max 1 mm/m. Start in the center of the room and install only in smaller confined areas. Pay attention to the arrow to get a uniform appearance.



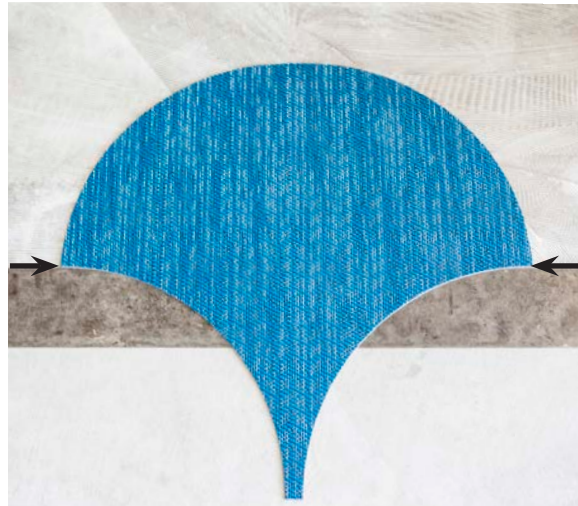
Picture 1. The white line shows direction of cross yarn (weft).

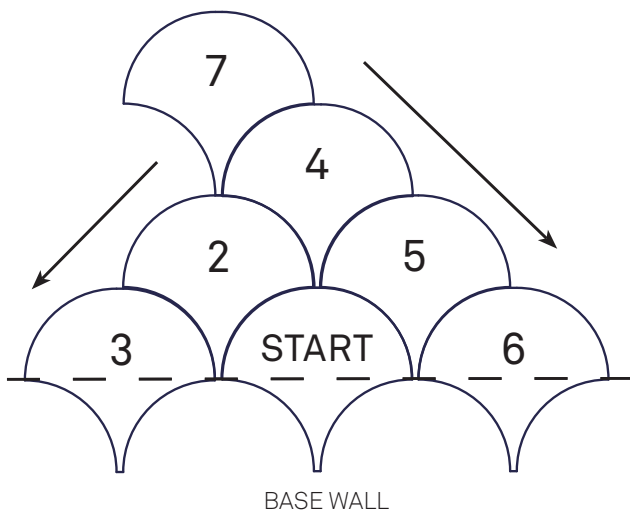
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR BOLON STUDIO™ SCALE



- Use a floor rule as reference line.
- Place it parallel and about one meter from the base wall.
- Glue a small area, maximum 3 meter wide, around the installation area center line. It is important to not glue too big area since wet gluing facilitate the installation procedure, because adjustment could be necessary.



- Place the first tile in center of reference line. The corners marked by arrows shall be placed edge to edge with the floor rule.



- Install in order according to picture and continue from the top of the pyramid.



- Finish the installation by installing the area between the reference line and the base wall.

Be careful "the tongue" is sensitive and can easily be moved in horizontal direction.
